

# Domino Server 8.0.x improvements

- New and enhanced messaging
  - Message recall
  - Web password lockout ("x" strikes rule)
  - -Improved Out-Of-Office sent immediately, not after 6 hours
- Dramatic improvements in admin, performance and security
- Sub processor licensing for VM installs
- Open applications infrastructure
  - Web services provider & consumer
- Consistent architecture, same skill set as R5 onwards





# Domino Server 8.5.x improvements

- DAOS-Domino Attachment and Object Service
  - Reduce overall NSF sizes by up to 77% in disk space
- ID Vault
- DCT Domino Configuration Tuner
- DDE-Domino Designer in Eclipse
- X-Pages design element (Java Server Faces)
- Native 64 bit OS support for Windows 2003 and AIX, others coming in subsequent releases
- FIPS 140-2 support
- iPhone support





## Notes/Domino 8.5 entitlements

- Existing entitlements from ND6/7
  - Integrated instant messaging/presence; functionally unchanged (other than graphical) from ND6/7
  - WebSphere Application Server 6.1 limited entitlement
- New entitlements in Notes/Domino 8
  - **Tivoli Directory Integrator**: For use when integrating Domino with non-Domino directories (such as LDAP, Active Directory)
  - Quickr Entry Edition : File and share content
  - DB2 9.1: Limited entitlement for storing Domino data only\*\*
  - Lotus Expeditor: Limited entitlement for use within context of Notes and composite applications
  - Lotus Component Designer: Entitled with Domino Designer 8
    - Intended to introduce Domino app developers to LCD




#### Domino 8.5 Server - DAOS

- My personal favorite requires transaction logging!
- It is <u>not</u> Shared Mail, it is <u>not</u> Shared Mail, it is <u>not</u> Shared Mail.
- Between 40% and 77% less overall storage required
  - Single instance storage of attachments/objects present in multiple NSF files residing on the same server
  - Stored as files on "file system"
  - Incremental backups
  - Actual NSF up to 90% smaller
  - Quotas still work
  - Secure, encrypted by default
  - No more copy and paste of NSF files between servers!
  - Backup implications

#### Domino 8.5 Server – DAOS

- Regardless of DAOS <u>you should</u> already be using TX Logging
  - Use a separate drive (preferable RAID1) or RAW LUN
  - Local storage is best performance
  - With "Archived" you can do point in time restores of an NSF
  - "Circular" will do fine
  - CREATE R85 LOG=1 in the notes.ini file
  - Also see Andy Pedisich's post at http://tinyurl.com/lqwv8v
- NLO files (the DAOS'd attachments) are encrypted with the server ID by default
- Run "tell daosmgr resync" after enabling it
- Keep away from 2048 bit server ID files (maybe fixed in FP1)
- Everything you ever wanted to know is on the blog



#### Domino 8.5 Server – ID Vault


- Who thinks "Password Recovery" is easy to manage and use?
- ID Vault allow for one-click password resets of ID files
- Requires ND 8.5+ Server AND client
- Stored in a Notes <del>database</del> application
  - No need to store ID files on
    - file share
    - usb drive
- Add to ID Vault to your backup
- During registration (via policy) ID can be added to ID Vault automatically
- Synchronizes passwords across multiple copies of ID file
- Notes will download the ID at client install time from the Vault
- Do not just replicate the Vault database application to other servers





#### Domino 8.5 Server – DCT

- Create an "optimally configured" Domino server with the DCT tool
- Ships with 8.5 Admin client as a template (dct.ntf)
  - Simply create a database, restart Notes, off you go
  - Will scan 8.5, 8.0.x and 7.0.x servers
  - Be sure to rescan after any upgrades
  - Updates to tool should be downloaded
  - Use with caution
    - There are some options that are "risky / RGE"





#### Domino 8.5 Server – Other Features

- Mail Router has been re-engineered, much better performance
- CPU cycles for transaction logging reduced by over 50%
- New transaction logging format
  - Be careful changing this
- Quickr Services for Domino 8.2 can use DAOS
- Performance improvements \* (for W64, other platforms similar):
  - Total disk operations per second reduced by 33%
  - Total disk reads per second reduced by 61%
  - Processor percent busy reduced by 38%



# Domino Designer - DDE

- Familiar, but better!
  - Extensible
  - Plug-in architecture
  - Real CSS, HTML and JS editors!
  - Working sets, love 'em or hate 'em
- There is no "basic" version
- Not everything has been Eclipsed. See 8.5.1
- Yes, it is somewhat slow. See 8.5.1
- Dojo is the JS toolkit of choice
  - Also used in Quickr
- See 8.5.1;)





# Domino Designer - XPages


- New web oriented design element
- XPages = JSF = Java Server Faces (JSR 127)
  - Yes, a real web development standard
- Separation of UI and data
  - XPages don't store any data (unlike a form)
  - Display multiple data sources on one page
    - Multiple documents and/or views
    - Multiple databases
- Drag-and-drop, like visual Eclipse or Visual Studio
  - Then wire the components together
- Behind the scenes (or not) it is XML
- More in 8.5.1;)





# Domino Designer - XPages


- UI is separated from design using CSS
- "Themes" can be used to change look and feel...
  - Of application
  - Of entire server
- Easy AJAX
  - Partial page refreshes at a click of a mouse
- Real web development
  - For a real web platform
- Create your own "controls"





# Domino Designer - XPages

- It is all just JavaScript, no Java honest
- Event driven coding just like Notes
- Full Domino object model in JS
- IBM converted 80%+ of @functions into JS too....
  - Just use a "," in place of a ";"
- Any JSF component can be imported too
- JS can execute in two places
  - Server-side (think agent)
  - Client-side (in browser)
  - You can still use WQO/S
- I18n and Locale support






# Domino Designer - XPages


# Domino Designer – Q&A

# Crystal Ball - 8.5.1

- DAOS comes to the replicator task and to the Notes client
- XPages in the client
  - Build it once for both web and client
  - Yes, I have seen it working :)
  - Performance enhancements
- LotusScript Editor in native Eclipse
  - Code complete
  - Object browser
- DDE is 60-70% faster when opening
- GZIP coming to the Domino HTTP stack (larger is not always better)





# Crystal Ball - 8.5.1

- Native iPhone Traveler support
- Lotus Protector (think Barracuda) integration into the Notes client
- Client "seems" much faster and snappier
- Better "attachment at top" handling
